**Application and Decision Dates for admission to the 2024/2025 school year**

The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	31 <sup>st</sup> of January 2024
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	12 <sup>th</sup> of February 2024
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	7 Days

The school shall cease accepting applications for admission to the special class on	9 <sup>th</sup> of March 2024
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application for admission to the special class is	23 <sup>rd</sup> of March 2024
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	7 Days
